Sealed Bids for the construction of the Lift Station Replacements and Improvements Project will be received, by Coloma Charter Township, at Coloma Charter Township Hall: 4919 Paw Paw Lake Road Michigan, 49038, until 5:00pm local time on February 17, 2021, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. Attendance to the public bid opening will be made available via teleconference. Meeting materials and call in number will be distributed to all plan holders prior to the meeting date. The Project consists of replacing six (6) existing wastewater lift stations, installing one (1) wastewater flow meter and rehabilitation of the existing wastewater system at various locations.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a unit price basis as indicated in the Bid Form.
