ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID

The City of Albion will receive bids for the construction of the City-Wide Sidewalk Improvements Project until 10:30 a.m., local time on the 16th day of February, 2021, at the Albion City Hall, 112 West Cass Street, Albion, Michigan, 49224 at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The work for which bids are being requested is located throughout the City of Albion. The work for which bids are being requested consists of sidewalk removal and replacement, sidewalk ramp removal and replacement, concrete curb & gutter removal and replacement, tree removals, drainage structure adjustments and casting replacements, and various appurtenances.

The Contract Documents are on file for examination at the Albion City Hall, 112 W. Cass Street, Albion, Michigan 49224; at the office of the Engineer, Wightman, 1670 Lincoln Road, Allegan, Michigan, 49010; at the office of Builders Exchange of Kalamazoo, 3431 East Kilgore Road, Kalamazoo, MI 49001-5513; and at the office of Builders Exchange of Lansing, 1240 E. Saginaw Street, Lansing, MI 48906.

The Contract Documents including plans and specifications may be obtained at the office of the ENGINEER, Wightman, 1670 Lincoln Road, Allegan, MI 49010, at a non-refundable cost of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each set of documents so obtained. An additional cost of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) will be charged for bid sets requiring shipping and handling. Additional sets may be obtained at a non-refundable cost of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00). Neither the OWNER nor the ENGINEER will be responsible for partial sets of documents obtained from any other source. Electronic sets of plans and specifications are available for free via the company's website. The Advertisement for Bids, Plan Holder's List, all Addenda, and the Bid Tabulation will be posted to the Wightman Web Page at www.gowightman.com/bids.

The City of Albion reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any irregularities in bidding.

A certified check or bank draft drawn on a solvent bank in the State of Michigan payable without condition to the City of Albion or a satisfactory bid bond executed by the bidder and a surety company, in an amount equal to 5 percent of the bid shall be submitted with each bid.

No bids may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for a period of sixty (60) days to allow the review of proposals and to allow completion of necessary financial arrangements.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond and Payment Bond in the amount of 100 percent of the Contract price. Bond forms are included in the Contract Documents.
