The City of Hartford will receive sealed bids for the construction of the Wastewater System Improvements Project until <u>4:00pm</u>, local time on the <u>8th day of August, 2022</u>, at the office of the City of Hartford, 19 West Main Street, Hartford, Michigan 49057 at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The work for which bids are being requested consists of the following:

Contract A - Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements

This project includes the construction of an equalization tank, installation of a ferric chloride day tank and piping, replacement of a polymer mixer, effluent launder covers, leveling equipment, lift station rehabilitation, pavement replacement, and various appurtenances.

Contract B - Forcemain & Gravity Sewer Replacement

This project includes 8" and 10" forcemain replacement, 8" sewer siphon replacement, 8" and 10" gravity sewer replacement and various appurtenances.

Contract C - Sewer Lining

This project includes 8", 15", 16", and 18" cast in place piping lining, manhole casting replacements, manhole lining, and various appurtenances.
