ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID

The Village of Galien will receive sealed bids for the construction of the Sanitary Sewer Lining Project at the office of the Village of Galien located at 121 Cleveland Ave, Galien, MI 49113, until 11 am, local time on the 2nd day of August 2022, at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The work for which bids are being requested consists of the following:

Contract

Provide cured-in-place pipe lining for rehabilitation of five individual gravity sewer pipes within the Village of Galien sanitary collection system. The pipes to be rehabilitated include 8-inch and 10-inch pipes. The locations are on 2nd Street between Grant and George (2nd Street), underneath the gas station near Pulaski Highway (Gas Station), and just north of the railroad between Grant and Cleveland (Backyard). The work requested includes all preparation work, lining and restoration of service and various appurtenances.

A certified check or bank draft drawn on a solvent bank in the State of Michigan payable without condition to the OWNER or a satisfactory bid bond executed by the bidder and a surety company, in an amount equal to five percent of the bid shall be submitted with each bid.

No bids may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for at least 90 days.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond and a Labor and Material Bond in the amount of 100 percent of the Contract price. Bond forms are included in the Contract Documents.
