Nottawaseppi Huron Band of the Potawatomi will receive sealed bids for the construction of the *Pow Wow Ground Access Culvert Replacement Project* until 3:00 pm local time on the 10th day of *March, 2023* at the office of the OWNER, *Nottawaseppi Huron Band of the Potawatomi*, Attn: Dan Green, 1485 Mno Bmadzewen Way, Fulton, MI 49052, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and reviewed.

The work for which bids are being requested consists of the following:

Removal of existing CMP culvert and installation of new concrete 38 foot long 10 ft x 6 ft box culvert and including: grading and paving of access drive and walking path, along with associated drainage improvements and bank stabilization, and other appurtenances.
