

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID

The City of Otsego will receive sealed bids for Distribution System Materials Inventory Verification Project until 10:00 a.m., local time on the 10th day of July, 2024, at Otsego City Hall, 117 E Orleans Street, Otsego, MI 49078 at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The work for which bids are being requested consists of the following:

- Notify property owners of verification work to be completed outside of the home or building via door hangers
- Complete 2 exterior verifications at each property according EGLE guidelines and the project specifications, including identification of material type at each location.

Neither the OWNER nor the ENGINEER will be responsible for partial sets of documents obtained from any other source. The Advertisement for Bids, Plan Holder's List, all Addenda, and the Bid Tabulation will also be posted on the Wightman website bidding page at www.gowightman.com/bids.

Bidders shall comply with the Elliott Larsen Civil Rights Act, 1976 PA 453, as amended, MCL 37.2101 *et seq.*, the Persons with Disabilities Civil Rights Act, 1976 PA 220, as amended, MCL 37.1101 *et seq.*, and all other federal, state, and local fair employment practices and equal opportunity laws and covenants that it shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment, to be employed in the performance of this project, with respect to his or her hire, tenure, terms, conditions, or privileges of employment, or any matter directly or indirectly related to employment, because of his or her race, religion, color, national origin, age, sex, height, weight, marital status, or physical or mental disability that is unrelated to the individual's ability to perform the duties of a particular job or position. Bidders shall comply with the Employers Engaging in Unfair Labor Practices Act, 1980 PA 278, as amended, MCL 423.321 *et seq.*

A certified check or bank draft drawn on a solvent bank in the State of Michigan payable without condition to the City of Otsego, or a satisfactory bid bond executed by the bidder and a surety company, in an amount equal to 5 percent of the bid shall be submitted with each bid.

No bids may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for a period of thirty (30) days to allow for the review of proposals and to allow completion of necessary financial arrangements.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond and Payment Bond in the amount of 100 percent of the Contract price. Bond forms are included in the Contract Documents.

This project is being funded through a grant from the Michigan Department of the Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy Community Technical, Managerial, and Financial Support for Lead Service Line Replacement Grant Program. The Contractor shall comply with all requirements of this granting agency.
