DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM MATERIALS INVENTORY VERIFICATION

The VILLAGE OF MENDON will receive sealed bids for the inspection of service line materials within the Village until **3pm, local time on the 16th day of September 2024 at 206 East Main Street, Mendon, MI 49072** at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

A non-mandatory Pre Bid Meeting will be held on September 9th, 2024 at 9am via Microsoft Teams. Please go to www.gowightman.com/bids, get on the planholders list and you will be invited to the pre-bid meeting and will receive all addenda.

The work for which bids are being requested consists of the following:

- Notify property owners of verification work to be completed on private property outside of the home or building via door hangers;
- Complete two exterior verifications at each property according to EGLE guidelines and the project specifications, including identification of material type and completion of the Survey123 electronic questionnaire including photos of each verification.
- This project is subject to the Davis-Bacon Act (requires Prevailing Wages).

Neither the OWNER nor the ENGINEER will be responsible for partial sets of documents obtained from any other source. The Advertisement for Bids, Plan Holder's List, all Addenda, and the Bid Tabulation will also be posted on the Wightman website bidding page at www.gowightman.com/bids.

A certified check or bank draft drawn on a solvent bank in the State of Michigan payable without condition to the VILLAGE OF MENDON, or a satisfactory bid bond executed by the bidder and a surety company, in an amount equal to 5 percent of the bid shall be submitted with each bid.

No bids may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for a period of sixty (60) days to allow for the review of proposals and to allow completion of necessary financial arrangements.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond and Payment Bond in the amount of 100 percent of the Contract price. Bond forms are included in the Contract Documents.
