ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID

The Pokagon Band of Potawatomi Indians (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the Water and Sewer Extensions to the City of Dowagiac. Bids for construction of the Project will be received at the **Pokagon Band Community Center** located at **27043 Potawatomi Trail, Dowagiac MI 49047**, until **Wednesday, December 18, 2024 at 11:30 am**, local time. At that time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The work for which bids are being requested consists of the following:

Contract

This project consists of extending 12 inch water main along M51 from the City of Dowagiac south to the Four Winds Casino, constructing new sanitary sewer collection systems at the Rodgers Lake, Crystal Springs and Four Winds/Commercial Campuses and lift stations and force main to transmit the wastewater to the City of Dowagiac clean water plant on M62 and the decommissioning of the existing wastewater treatment facilities. Restoration and various appurtenances is included.

The OWNER reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any irregularities in bidding. The use of local contractors and labor is encouraged.

A certified check or bank draft drawn on a solvent bank in the State of Michigan payable without condition to the OWNER or a satisfactory bid bond executed by the bidder and a surety company, in an amount equal to 5 percent of the bid shall be submitted with each bid.

No bids may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for at least ninety (90) days so the Township can complete the required assessment hearings after the bid opening.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond and a Payment Bond in the amount of 100 percent of the Contract price. Bond forms are included in the Contract Documents.
