ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The Calhoun County Road Department will receive sealed bids for the construction of the D Drive N Culvert Replacement Project until 12:00 PM, local time on the 29th day of May, 2019, at the office of the Calhoun County Road Department, 13300 15 Mile Road, Marshall, Michigan 49068, at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Base Bid

Construction of a new 29' x 7' skewed precast 3-sided concrete box culvert, headwalls and wingwalls, soil erosion and sedimentation control measures, grade establishment, sand subbase, aggregate base, slope protection, restoration and traffic control on D Drive N, approximately 500' west of Beadle Lake Road in Emmett Charter Township, Calhoun County. The unit prices bid for the Base Bid shall include all work as shown in the plans and specifications.

All work shall be performed in accordance with the Michigan Department of Transportation's 2012 Standard Specifications for Construction or as modified by these Project Specifications.

An additional cost of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) will be charged for bid sets requiring shipping and handling. Additional sets may be obtained at a non-refundable cost of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00). Neither the OWNER nor the ENGINEER will be responsible for partial sets of documents obtained from any other source. The Advertisement for Bids, Plan Holder's List, Plans, Contract Documents and Specifications, and all Addenda and Bid Tabulation will be posted to the Wightman web page at "<http://gowightman.com/bids>".

The OWNER reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any irregularities in bidding. The use of local contractors and labor is encouraged.

A certified check or bank draft drawn on a solvent bank in the State of Michigan payable without condition to the OWNER or a satisfactory bid bond executed by the bidder and a surety company, in an amount equal to 5 percent of the bid shall be submitted with each bid.

No bids may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for at least seventy-five (75) days.
