

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The Village of Baroda will receive sealed bids for the Industrial Park Road Project until 3:00 pm Local Time, on the 17th day of June 2019 at the Village of Baroda Municipal Building, 9091 First Street, P.O. Box 54 Baroda, MI 49101. All bids will be publicly opened and read aloud shortly thereafter.

The work for which bids are being requested consists of water main, sanitary sewer, storm sewer and complete road construction as follows:

Contract

Construction of a new roadway to serve the Industrial Park in the Village of Baroda. The project will include an approximately 1,300 feet of new HMA roadway at 32' wide with curb and gutter. Installation of new watermain, sanitary sewer, and storm sewer are Included as part of this project. New water main will also be installed along Hills Road to complete the loop through the Village. For a detailed pay item list, see bid form pages 24-26.

The Contract Documents including plans and specifications may be obtained at the office of the ENGINEER, Wightman & Associates Inc., 2303 Pipestone Road, Benton Harbor, Michigan 49022, at a *non-refundable* cost of *Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)* for each set of documents so obtained. An additional cost of *Ten Dollars (\$10.00)* will be charged for plans requiring shipping and handling. Neither the OWNER nor the ENGINEER will be responsible for partial sets of documents obtained from any other source. The Advertisement for Bids, Plan Holder's List, all Addenda, and the Bid Tabulation will be posted to the Wightman & Associates, Inc. Web Page at <http://gowightman.com/bids>.

A certified check or bank draft drawn on a solvent bank in the State of Michigan payable without condition to the Village of Baroda, Michigan, or a satisfactory bid bond executed by the bidder and a surety company, in an amount not less than five (5%) percent of the bid shall be submitted with each bid.

No bids may be withdrawn after the opening of the bids for a period of ninety (90) days to allow the review of proposals and to allow completion of necessary financial arrangements.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance and Labor and Materials Bond in the amount of 100 percent of the Contract Price. Sample bond forms are included in the Contract Documents.

A voluntary pre-bid conference will be held at 9:00am (local time) on the 30th day of May 2019, at the Village of Baroda Municipal Building. Representatives of the OWNER and professional personnel will be present to discuss the project. Bidders are encouraged to attend and participate in the conference. The ENGINEER will transmit to all prospective bidders of record such addenda, as the ENGINEER considers necessary in response to questions arising at the conference. Oral statements may not be relied upon and will not be binding or legally effective.

This project is being funded in part through a loan/grant from the United States Department of Agriculture, Rural Development. The CONTRACTOR must comply with all requirements of this Agency.

The term “iron and steel products” means the following products made primarily of iron or steel: lined or unlined pipes and fittings, manhole covers and other municipal castings, hydrants, tanks, flanges, pipe clamps and restraints, valves, structural steel, reinforced precast concrete, and construction materials.
