ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID

The Village of Cassopolis will receive sealed bids for the construction of the **Lift Station #1 Discharge Manhole Replacements Project** until **10:00 A.M.**, local time on the **25th** day of **February, 2020**, at the Cassopolis Village Hall, 117 S. Broadway Street, Suite 100, Cassopolis, Michigan 49031. All bids will be publicly opened and read aloud shortly thereafter.

The work for which bids are being requested consists of the following:

1 LS Mobilization; 1 EA 4' Diameter Manhole, Remove; 2 EA 4' Diameter Manhole, Abandon; 3 EA Manhole, Abandon In Place; 1 LS Blower Structure, Abandon; 1 EA 4' Diameter Concrete Manhole; 4 EA 4' Diameter Concrete Doghouse Manhole; 45 VF Polyurea Manhole Lining; 85 LFT 12" PVC Force Main; and various appurtenances.

The Contract Documents including plans and specifications may be obtained at the office of the ENGINEER, Wightman, 2303 Pipestone Road, Benton Harbor, MI 49022, at a non-refundable cost of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each set of documents so obtained. An additional cost of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) will be charged for bid sets requiring shipping and handling. The bid documents may be downloaded from the Wightman website at no cost (www.gowightman.com/bids). Neither the OWNER nor the ENGINEER will be responsible for partial sets of documents obtained from any other source. The Advertisement for Bid, Plan Holder's List, all Addenda, and the Bid Tabulation will be posted to the Wightman Web Page at www.gowightman.com/bids.

The OWNER reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any irregularities in bidding. The use of local contractors and labor is encouraged.

A certified check or bank draft drawn on a solvent bank in the State of Michigan payable without condition to the OWNER or a satisfactory bid bond executed by the bidder and a surety company, in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the bid shall be submitted with each bid.

No bids may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for at least ninety (90) days.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond and a Labor and Material Bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract price. Bond forms are included in the Contract Documents.
