ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID

New Buffalo Township will receive sealed bids for the construction of the Fire Station No. 2 Water and Sewer Extension Project until 10:00 a.m., local time on the 11th of May, 2020, at the New Buffalo Township Hall, 17425 Red Arrow Highway New Buffalo, Michigan 48117 at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids may be dropped off at the New Buffalo Township Office dropbox prior to the bid opening. The ENGINEER will transmit to all prospective bidders of record such addenda, as the ENGINEER considers necessary in response to questions arising prior to bid opening. Oral statements may not be relied upon and will not be binding or legally effective.

The work for which bids are being requested consists of one contract as follows:

1 LS Traffic Maintenance and Control, 1 EA Connect to Existing 16" Water main - Wet Tap Method, 1 EA Connect to Existing 8" Water main, 1,160 LFT Water main, 8-inch, 20 LFT Water main, 6-inch, 1 EA Gate Valve and Box, 8-inch 1 EA Gate Valve and Box, 4-inch, 1 EA 4" Water Service Connection, 20 LFT 4" Water Service Pipe, 1 EA 6-inch Hydrant Assembly, 1 EA Connect to Existing Manhole, 1,040 LFT Sanitary Sewer, 8", 4 EA Sanitary Sewer Manhole, 4' Diameter, 5 LFT Sewer Lateral Pipe, 4", 1 EA 8" x 4" Wye.

Neither the OWNER nor the ENGINEER will be responsible for partial sets of documents obtained from any other source. The OWNER reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any irregularities in bidding. The use of local contractors and labor is encouraged.

A certified check or bank draft drawn on a solvent bank in the State of Michigan payable without condition to the OWNER or a satisfactory bid bond executed by the bidder and a surety company, in an amount equal to 5 percent of the bid shall be submitted with each bid.

No bids may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for at least ninety (90) days.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond and a Labor and Material Bond in the amount of 100 percent of the Contract price. Bond forms are included in the Contract Documents.
