

**ONTWA TOWNSHIP
LIFT STATION C-1 IMPROVEMENTS**

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID

The Ontwa Township will receive sealed bids for the construction of the Lift Station C-1 Improvements until 11:00 am, local time on the 15th day of July, 2020, at the office of Ontwa Township Hall, 26225 US Hwy. 12, Edwardsburg, MI 49112 at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The work for which bids are being requested consists of the following:

Contract

This contract includes improvements at the existing C-1 lift station for Ontwa Township located at the intersection of Elkhart Road and Sandy Beach Drive, Edwardsburg, Michigan. The work includes: removing two existing poly tanks, providing and installing two new double walled polymer tanks (550 gallons and 5,000 gallons), providing and installing electrical, controls and two chemical feed pumps in a cabinet pumps for new chemical feeds for bioxide and caustic and associated feed lines installed in conduit, concrete flatwork including a drive and flatwork within the limits of the station, and the installation of a standalone emergency shower unit to be supplied by the Township. The work will also include the providing and installing a new 6-foot pre-cast concrete manhole to house a wastewater grinder on a rail system (Vogelsang X-Ripper) upstream of the existing station.

The Contract Documents including plans and specifications may be obtained via electronic download from the ENGINEER's website below. Neither the OWNER nor the ENGINEER will be responsible for partial sets of documents obtained from any other source. The Advertisement for Bids, Plan Holder's List, all Addenda, and the Bid Tabulation will be posted to the Wightman Web Page at www.bids.gowightman.com.

There will be a pre-bid walk-thru of the site on Monday, July 6th at 9:00 a.m. to provide bidders access to the site.

The OWNER reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any irregularities in bidding. The use of local contractors and labor is encouraged.

A certified check or bank draft drawn on a solvent bank in the State of Michigan payable without condition to the OWNER or a satisfactory bid bond executed by the bidder and a surety company, in an amount equal to 5 percent of the bid shall be submitted with each bid.

No bids may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for at least ninety (90) days.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond and a Labor and Material Bond in the amount of 100 percent of the Contract price. Bond forms are included in the Contract Documents.
